The issue contains two stamps. The winning motive for the collaborative design by Linda Bos and Runa Egilsdottir (A Designers Collective) is a new sign representing peace based on the European, centuries-old visual motive of the knot, a symbol of endless unity, friendship and love. The second stamp is the work of Marin Musa, showing a white dove carrying an olive branch. It symbolizes peace as the greatest value of humanity. The sky in the body of the dove symbolizes that we are all one under the sky. The olive branch in its beak represents fulfilment and hope after dark times. The dove carries a message of harmony and indicates that wars and conflicts are never the solution.



Indian politician and leader Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi (1869 - 1948), known as Mahatma, meaning "great soul" in Sanskrit, fought for India's independence by non-violent means. Gandhi's teachings, messages of nonviolence and hunger strikes became an inspiration for nonviolent movements in other parts of the world. Mahatma Gandhi was shot dead by Hindu traditionalist Nathuram Godse on January 30, 1948 for believing he was offending Indian tradition and religion.

The winner was decided by a divine council that gave priority to Athena and since then the olive has become a symbol of peace.




Medjugorje 2021.

The motifs are the Franciscan church of St Peter and Paul in Mostar, Cathedral Church of the Holy Trinity in Mostar, Mostar Synagogue and the Karađoz-bay's mosque in Mostar that are not only beautiful sacral objects but also special architectural solutions that enrich the city on the Neretva river.





In the Gospel of Matthew, an event is described when, following the Star of Bethlehem, three wise men or kings from the East came to worship Jesus.

They are most commonly depicted and represented as men of various life stages (young, mature, and elderly) and different races or skin colours. It is not known where they came from or what their names were, but since the 8th century, the names Balthasar, Melchior, and Gaspar have become commonly associated with them. The gifts they brought to the child Jesus also have their symbolism: myrtle was given as a gift to him as a man, incense as a gift to him as God, and gold as a gift to him as a King.

Franciscans and education in Bosnia and Herzegovina



The Croatian Post Mostar, through its stamp releases on the topic of ethnological treasures, preserves the material, social, and spiritual heritage of the Croatian people. Every society has its customs related to significant moments in life, and one such event is the birth of a child. The motif of the "Ethnological Treasure 2023" edition is a cradle, a handcrafted wooden crib for a young child.

The human need to tell stories gave life to theatre in ancient Greece. The World Theatre Day was founded in 1961 at the suggestion of the International Theatre Institute and is celebrated every year on 27 March.

A puppet theatre is a special kind of theatre which includes the human manipulation of puppets to tell a story. One such theatre - the Mostar Puppet Theatre has been telling fairytale stories to children for 70 years, introducing them to the world of theatre culture in a way they can understand.



The first public school in Bosnia and Herzegovina was founded in Tolisa near Orašje in 1823. It was founded by Brother Ilija Starčević. In the first year, about eighty students were enrolled in the school. The Franciscans have been present in Tolisa since the Middle Ages, and the Tolis monastery dates to the second half of the 19th century, when the Franciscans in that part of Bosnia decided to build a monastery on Raščica.

The Franciscan Juraj Dragišić was a humanist, philosopher, theologian, provincial and (arch) bishop. Born around 1445 in Srebrenica, died 1520 as Archbishop in Barletta, Italy. He enjoyed such a reputation that he became a member of the Platonic Academy. As Bishop of Nazareth in Barletta, he attended the Fifth Lateran Council, where he proposed the reform of the Julian calendar.

Vitko's stećak in the shape of a ridge, with an ornamental three-leafed vine woven around it, dates to the 14th or 15th century. The stećak bears the inscription written in Bosnian Cyrillic script or Bosančica and three figural ornaments: a male figure, circular dance (kolo) and deer hunt.




International Literacy Day was established by UNESCO in 1967 with the aim of promoting the importance of literacy and learning. In Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Sisters of Charity made an immeasurable contribution to education and thus left an indelible mark on our nation. From Zagreb, at the invitation of the bishop Fr. Paškal Vuičić, on November 14, 1871, the Sisters of Mercy of St. Vinko Paulski to serve the needy. After the Second World War, all their property was confiscated illegally. Also, in the last war, the sisters experienced a difficult fate. They were expelled from their monasteries and almost all their monasteries were destroyed. Religious teacher, catechist and organist S. Cecilija Grgić was killed and burned in Banja Luka together with the parish priest, the Reverend Filip Lukend. Today, the Sisters of Mercy in Bosnia and Herzegovina have 12 monasteries and are active in educational, health and socialcharitable activities.

Džoka is a part of men's and women's costume, a short sleeveless cloak made of finer fabric, as a component of the costume of the local people of earlier times, especially the people of western Herzegovina. Original specimens of this garment are rare and belong to the ethnological treasure of Herzegovina

The picture shows the "chest part" of this waistcoat, in the photo of the old Association of Saint Anthony of Padua, founded in 1872 in the Franciscan monastery in Mostar. At the time, the Association was the sponsor of numerous social, cultural and educational events in Herzegovina.





The most significant myth of Slavic mythology is the fight between Perun and Veles who steals the Sun - Mokoš and takes it to the underworld.



Croatian nobles, military leaders and poets Ban Fran Krsto Frankopan and Duke Petar Zrinski were executed in Vienna Neustadt on 30 April 1671, after a failed conspiracy by the Croatian and Hungarian nobility, dissatisfied with the policy of the Vienna court. The Zrinski family has its origins in the Šubić family, one of the 12 old Croatian medieval tribes, and along with the Frankopan family it belongs to the most important and most famous Croatian noble families. Mladen I. and Mladen II. Šubić Bribirski were Bosnian bans, and Jelena Šubić was the mother of the Bosnian king Tvrtko I.

World Wetlands Day - Livanjsko field

World Wetlands Day is celebrated on February 2 to alert the public to the need for their protection and preservation. Bosnia and Herzegovina ratified the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands on September 24, 2001 and currently has three habitats that have met the criteria: Livanjsko Polje, Hutovo Blato Nature Park and the Bardača site.

Livanjsko polje covers 46,000 hectares and is one of the largest in the world. It is a combination of wetlands, important bird habitats, peatlands and meadows where endemic and rare species live.



World Animal Day was proclaimed in 1931 at the Congress of Ecologists in Florence and is celebrated on October 4th, the feast of the patron saint of animals, Francis of Assisi. The Japanese Akita (Akita Inu) comes from the Japanese province of the same name. The original name of the breed was Akita Matagi and the dogs were used for bear hunting. From 1600 to 1868 it was used for dog fighting and as a heavy weapon carrier for samurai. At a certain period of Japanese history, it could only be owned by nobles.



Edelweiss (Leontopodium alpinum) belongs to the Asteraceae family. It is a rare plant, protected throughout Europe, and is a symbol of mountain regions. Alpine Bartsia (Bartsia alpina) is a perennial herbaceous plant belonging to the broomrape family (Orobanchaceae). The fruit, in the form of a hairy quiver, is approximately 1 cm in length. It grows in grassy habitats ranging from meadows to clearings.

Fauna 2023 - Bats

Bats are a crucial part of the ecosystem. Based on the number of recorded species, Bosnia and Herzegovina is one of the richest countries in Europe when it comes to these mammals. The Blasius Horseshoe Bat (Rhinolophus blasii) is the rarest horseshoe bat in Europe. In this part of the Dinarides, its only known mainland colony is located near Mostar. The Lesser Horseshoe Bat (Rhinolophus hipposideros) is the smallest bat species in Europe and is highly endangered. The Common noctule (Nyctalus noctula) is a large bat with broad, rounded ears that migrates from Central Europe to the Mediterranean. The Mediterranean long-eared bat (Plecotus kolombatovici) is associated with the Adriatic region.




Fauna 2021. - The beech marten and the pine marten, The weasel and The European polecat

Black grouse belong to the genus of forest birds from the order of chicken (Galliformes), living in dense mountain forests and feeding on various fruits and berries, leaves, buds, grass, and in winter with the needles of coniferous trees.

Flora 2021 - Lady's Slipper orchid and Fly Orchid

Orchids are considered one of the most beautiful species of flowers, and about 1,000 genera with 15,000 to 30,000 species are known. The Lady's Slipper and the Fly Orchid are among the endangered plant species in BiH. The Lady's Slipper (Cypripedium calceolus) is one of the rarest and most beautiful orchids in Europe. It is named after the flowers, which are shaped like a small slipper. The Fly Orchid (Ophrys insectifera) is a unique-looking orchid. It grows on grasslands on limestone grounds, in oak forests and in hedges along rural roads, paths and routes.

The International Day of Sports for Development and Peace is traditionally marked by the Croatian Post Mostar with the issue of postage stamps. In 2023, the theme is chess, one of the oldest and most widespread board games. The chess board is square in shape and divided into 64 squares that are alternately coloured light and dark. In the starting position there are 16 white and 16 black pieces (one king and one queen each, 2 rooks, bishops and knights and 8 pawns each).




International Day of Sport for Development and Peace 2021 - Swimming


