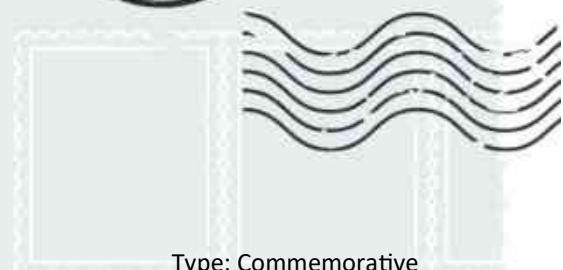

The Triton's trumpet and the giant tun are the largest sea snails in the Adriatic Sea and are classified as rare and protected species. Triton's trumpet (*Charonia*) is spindle-shaped, with a large opening and an oval operculum. Its name is associated with the Greek god Triton, son of Poseidon, the god of the sea. The giant tun (*Tonna galea*) has a large and fragile barrel-shaped shell. One of its rare characteristics is its ability to luminesce; when moving through the water with its foot fully extended, it glows with a greenish colour.

The Roman snail (*Helix pomatia*) is one of the largest terrestrial snails. On its head it has two pairs of thin retractable tentacles, with the eyes located at the tips of the longer pair. The grove snail (*Cepaea nemoralis*) is one of the most common land snails in Europe. Their shells can vary in colour — from white and yellow to brown or black — and may feature one to five dark brown or black stripes.

The date mussel (*Lithophaga lithophaga*) is a marine bivalve from the mussel family (*Mytilidae*) that lives along the coasts of the Mediterranean Sea (including the Adriatic Sea), the Atlantic Ocean, and the Red Sea. They are considered an exceptional delicacy, and in many countries their harvesting is prohibited.

Algae is a collective name for aquatic plants found all over the world, and they play an important ecological role as primary producers of organic matter in aquatic environments.

The **horned lark** (*Eremophila alpestris*) is a species of passerine bird belonging to the genus *Eremophila*. It is about 16 cm long, with a distinctive black and yellow facial pattern, brown-grey colouring on the upper side, and white on the underside.

The **grey wagtail** (*Motacilla cinerea*) is a slender bird with a long black tail edged in white. This timid and lively bird is constantly on the move and is characterised by its continuous tail-wagging. It has a pale yellow belly, while its back is grey.

The **corn crane** (*Crex crex*) is a bird that is rarely seen because it hides in dense grass. It has light, camouflage-coloured plumage.

The **white-throated dipper** (*Cinclus cinclus*) is a passerine bird and is unique among this order because it can dive and swim underwater. It is most commonly dark brown or brown-and-white in colour.

Bats are mammals that play an important role in maintaining natural balance. They fly at night in order to avoid competition for food with numerous daytime insect-hunting birds and to escape the danger of daytime predators. Based on the number of recorded species, Bosnia and Herzegovina is one of the richest countries in Europe.

Blasius's horseshoe bat (*Rhinolophus blasii*) is the rarest horseshoe bat in Europe. In this part of the Dinaric region, its only known mainland colony is located near Mostar, in the Prosječenica cave on Podveležje.

The lesser horseshoe bat (*Rhinolophus hipposideros*) is the smallest bat species in Europe and is highly endangered.

The noctule (*Nyctalus noctula*) is a large bat with broad, rounded ears that migrates from Central Europe to the Mediterranean.

Kolombatović's long-eared bat (*Plecotus kolombatovici*) is associated with the Adriatic region. It has exceptionally large ears, which it uses for orientation and detecting prey through sound.
